

DOMESTIC ELECTRICAL CIRCUITS MODULE 3G - 3N

METALLIC CONDUIT INSTALLATION COURSE - MODULE 3G

A 1 Day course which gives you the skills to successfully install black enamel and galvanised conduit systems.

TRUNKING INSTALLATION COURSE - MODULE 3H

A 2 Day course which gives you the skills to successfully install PVC, metallic and pre-wired busbar trunking systems successfully.

TRAY, LADDER AND BASKET INSTALLATION COURSE - MODULE 3I

A 2 Day course which gives you the skills to successfully install light duty, medium duty return flange and heavy duty return flange cable tray, along with cable ladder and the new basket systems. This course also covers the use of 'unistrut' and the appropriate support systems, fixings and the necessary tooling.

CABLE JOINTING COURSE - MODULE 3J (SUPPLEMENTARY CHARGE OF £50)

A 1 Day course which gives you the skills to successfully joint armoured cables using compound filled joints.

ELECTRICITY AT WORK REGULATIONS COURSE - MODULE 3K

A 1 Day course which provides an insight into the use and application of the EAW Regulations 1989. This course is designed to make the participant aware of his/her duties under these regulations and the duties imposed on employers and employees.

CERTIFICATE FILLING COURSE - MODULE 3L

A 1 Day course aimed at anyone involved in the completion or handling of electrical certification and/or reports.

This course was originally developed at the request of a large housing association, which had various electrical contractors inspecting and testing their properties, and receiving certification that was incorrectly completed.

If you need to know whether or not your certificates are being completed correctly, then this is the course for you.

LAMP REPLACEMENT AND DISPOSAL - MODULE 3M

A 1 day course developed originally for a London based company who were paying in excess of £40/lamp for a straightforward 'one out one in' replacement. Aimed at persons such as general buildings maintenance staff who need to safely carry out the replacement of fluorescent, low voltage halogen and general purpose lamps, it is assumed the candidate has little or no electrical knowledge, prior to attending the course.

CABLE SIZING - MODULE 3N

This course is a section of our City and Guilds 2391-02 design course, and as such is a good 'taster' as to what that course holds, it is aimed at the design novice and anyone who is currently 'winging it' i.e.... its always been 2.5mm² so why should it be any different now?
